- **NOTE: All students in video must sign media release consent form provided by their school.**

Your video will be judged based on the following:

1. Effectiveness and creativity in expressing the theme: **TAKING A STAND AGAINST RACISM**
2. Production quality
3. Keeping to the rules. Your schools video must:
 - a) be between 45-60 seconds
 - b) be submitted on CD or DVD
 - c) be accompanied by one entry form
 - d) do not contain any images not created by the entrants (such as pictures, photographs, stock film or images from the internet) without a written letter of permission from the person having rights to the images allowing their use in the video for the purposes of the competition and granting LUSO Community Services the right to use all video images they receive as they see fit. Remember to include, unless he/she stated otherwise, the name of the author of the images in the credits of the video; and
 - e) use only original music (i.e. music you and/or your team composed) or use royalty-free and rights free music.
 - f) No videos will be considered if the images, tone, theme, are deemed inappropriate.

No video entries will be returned. This means LUSO Community Services will have the right to use all video images they receive as they see fit. Entrants will also be required to prove that all persons connected with the production of the video and all other persons whose names, voices, photographs, likenesses, work, services and materials used in the video have authorized the use of their names, voices, photographs, likenesses, performances, and data in connection with the distribution, advertising, promotion and exploitation of the video. The contest closes **Friday February 10, 2012 at 5pm.**

No responsibility will be taken for entries that are incomplete, damaged, misdirected or delayed. To enter and be eligible to win students must be 18 years old or younger, be a registered full time student and a resident of London or Middlesex and has the consent of his/her parent /guardian (if he she has not reached 18 years of age) and not an employee of, a member of the immediate family of, or living with an employee of any organization participating in this initiative, sponsors and partners associated with this competition. Prizes are subject to change without notification and must be accepted as awarded. No substitutions will be made, transfers permitted, or refunds allowed-cash or otherwise.

All entrants shall submit with their video entry, signed by their parent or legal Guardian, Principal or a Declaration of Release waiving all moral rights attached to the work(s) which is part of the entry form, if they have not reached the age of majority before receiving their prize. By entering contestants agree to abide by the contest rules and the final decisions of the contest organizers, and they agree to the use of their name, photograph and likeness in any form of media for publicity purposes in connection with the initiative and without compensation. Any personal information collected for the purposes of the competition will only be used or disclosed for that purpose and in accordance with the *Privacy Act of Canada*. In providing such information participants or their parent/guardian do consent to the use of such information as indicated. The parent or the legal guardian will become responsible for anything related to the entry, the competition or the awarding of prizes, if the winner has not reached the age of majority.
